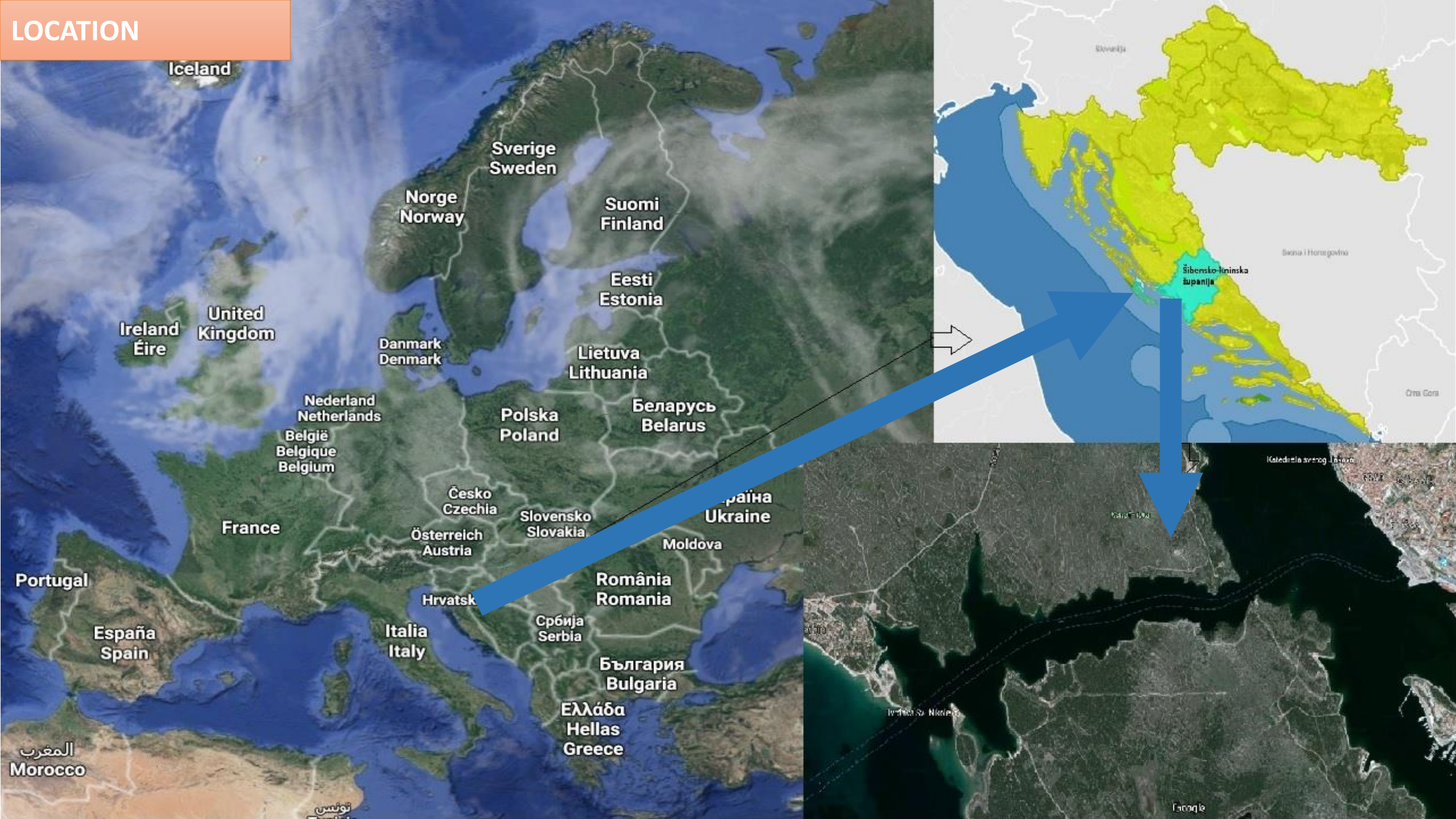

LOCATION





The Šibenik – Knin County is situated in the middle part of the Croatian Adriatic Sea, with a surface area of 5670 km². It is equally land (2994 km²) as it is sea (2676 km²). The coastal part is extremely indented, consisting of many bays and over 280 islands, islets and rocks.

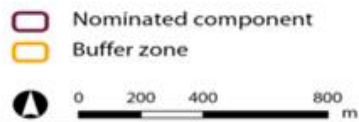

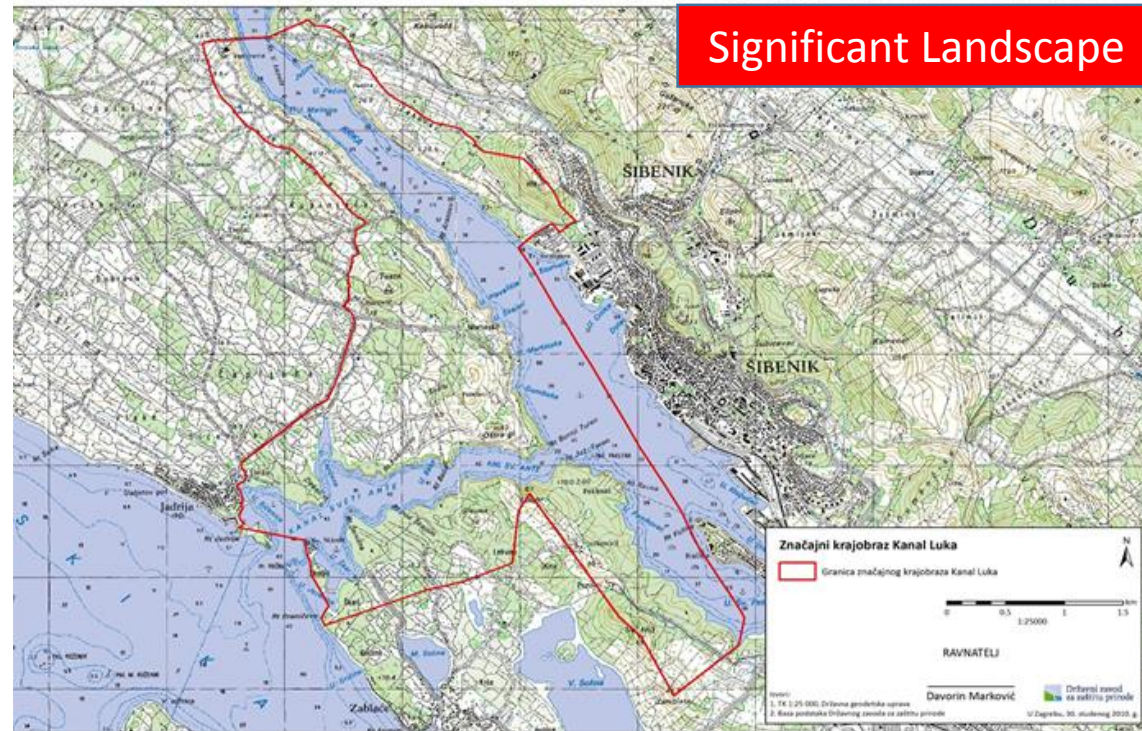

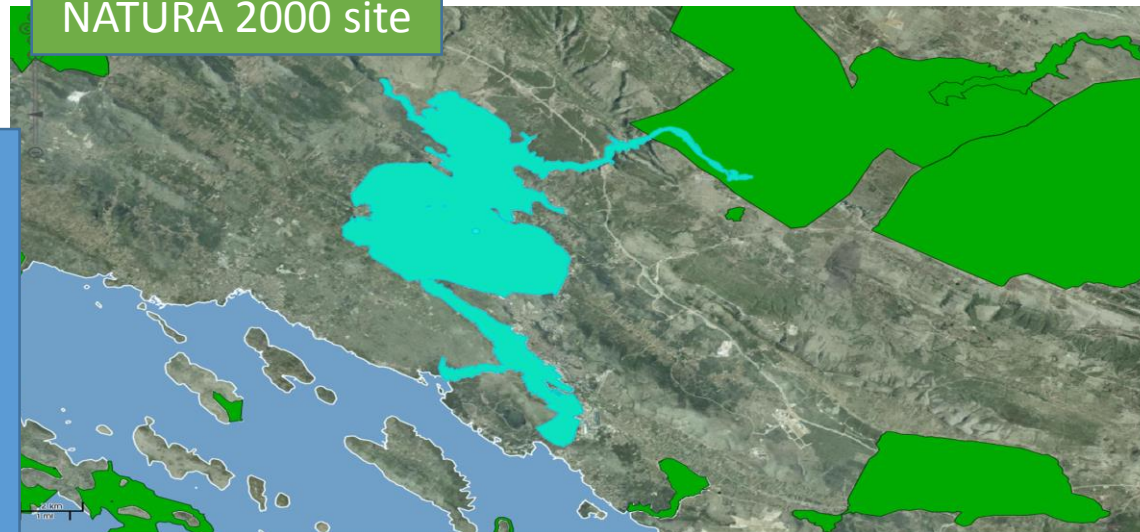

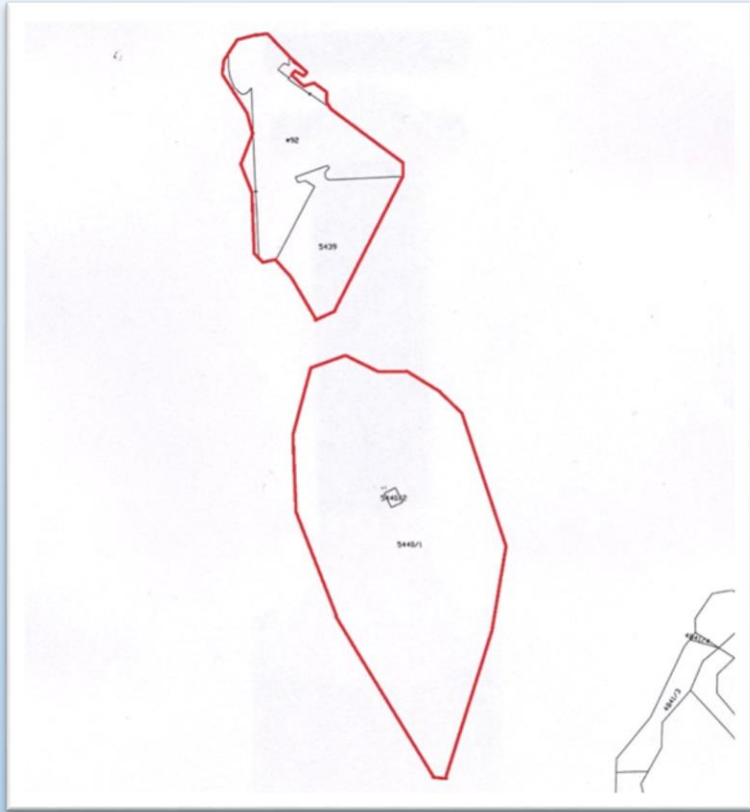


NATURA 2000 site



The whole area of the fortress is protected by the laws of national protection. The area chosen as buffer zone has been selected within the 'Channel – Port in Šibenik' area, categorized as „Protected Areas-Category V,, in the IUCN classification, characterized by a "Significant Importance". Furthermore, this area is part of the European ecological network NATURA 2000 "Mouth of river Krka"

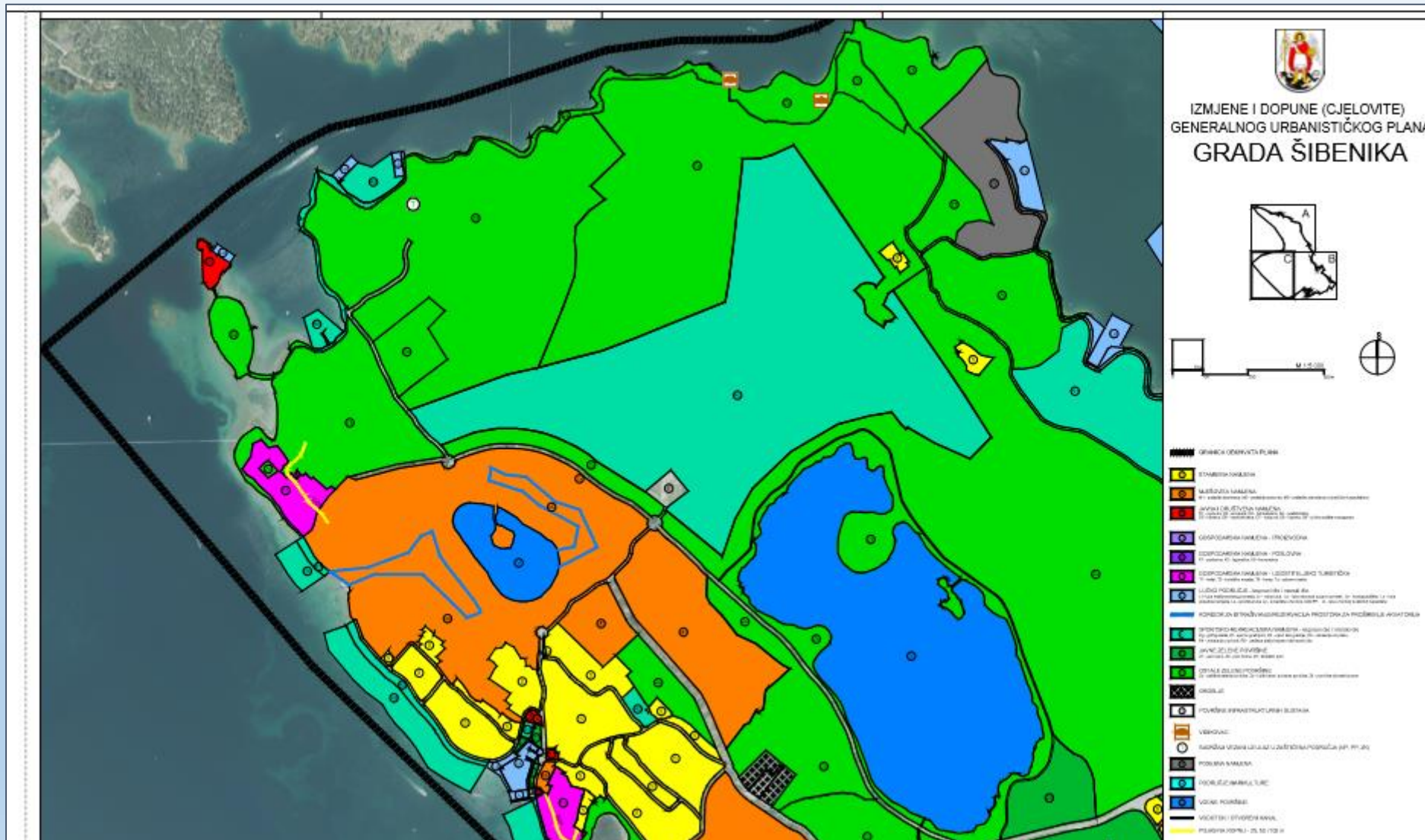

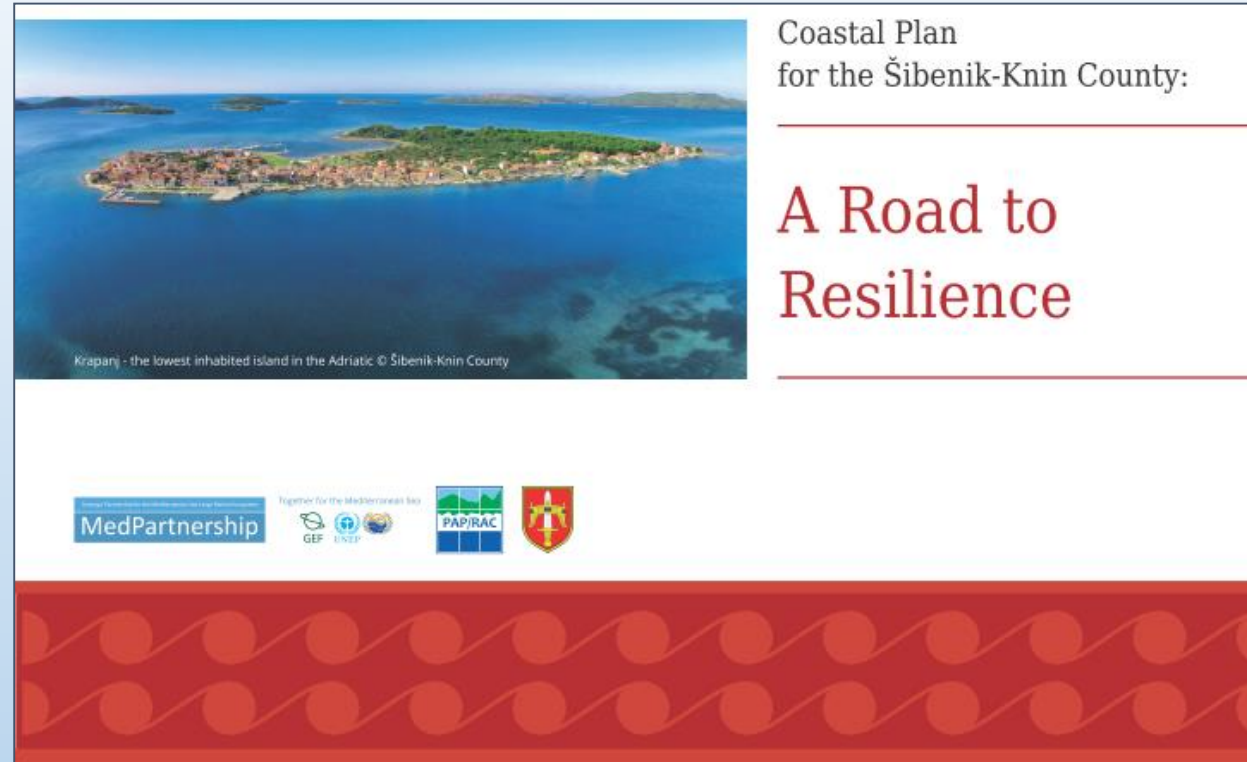
En savoir+ :

Le projet consiste à développer sur une péninsule de 1000 hectares, un village touristique de 300 ha, avec 800 000 m² de surface construite, 4500 villas et appartements et environ 800 chambres d'hôtel. Ce complexe se développe au centre d'un aménagement de 2 golfs de 18 trous et d'une marina de 200 anneaux connectée à la mer adriatique par plusieurs canaux et développant 3600 maisons type "Port Grimaud".

Le projet inclut:

- 1550 villas, dont 1400 proches de la marina et 150 sur les golfs
- 3000 appartements d'environ 100m² dans des petits immeubles de 3 niveaux sur le canal principal
- 5 hôtels et 2 hôtels résidence
- 22 500 m² de surface commerciale

Le projet se développe en 2 phases, la 1ère phase de 400 000 m² se concentrant sur le canal, la zone de la marina et des "maisons de pêcheurs", de 3 hôtels et du 1er golf 18 trous. La 2ème phase sur la "petite Venise", le second golf et les maisons des golfs et du lac.



The Plan was drawn up in accordance with the Article 18 of the Protocol on Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM) in the Mediterranean. The Mediterranean Protocol on the ICZM was signed in Madrid in 2008 by the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention.

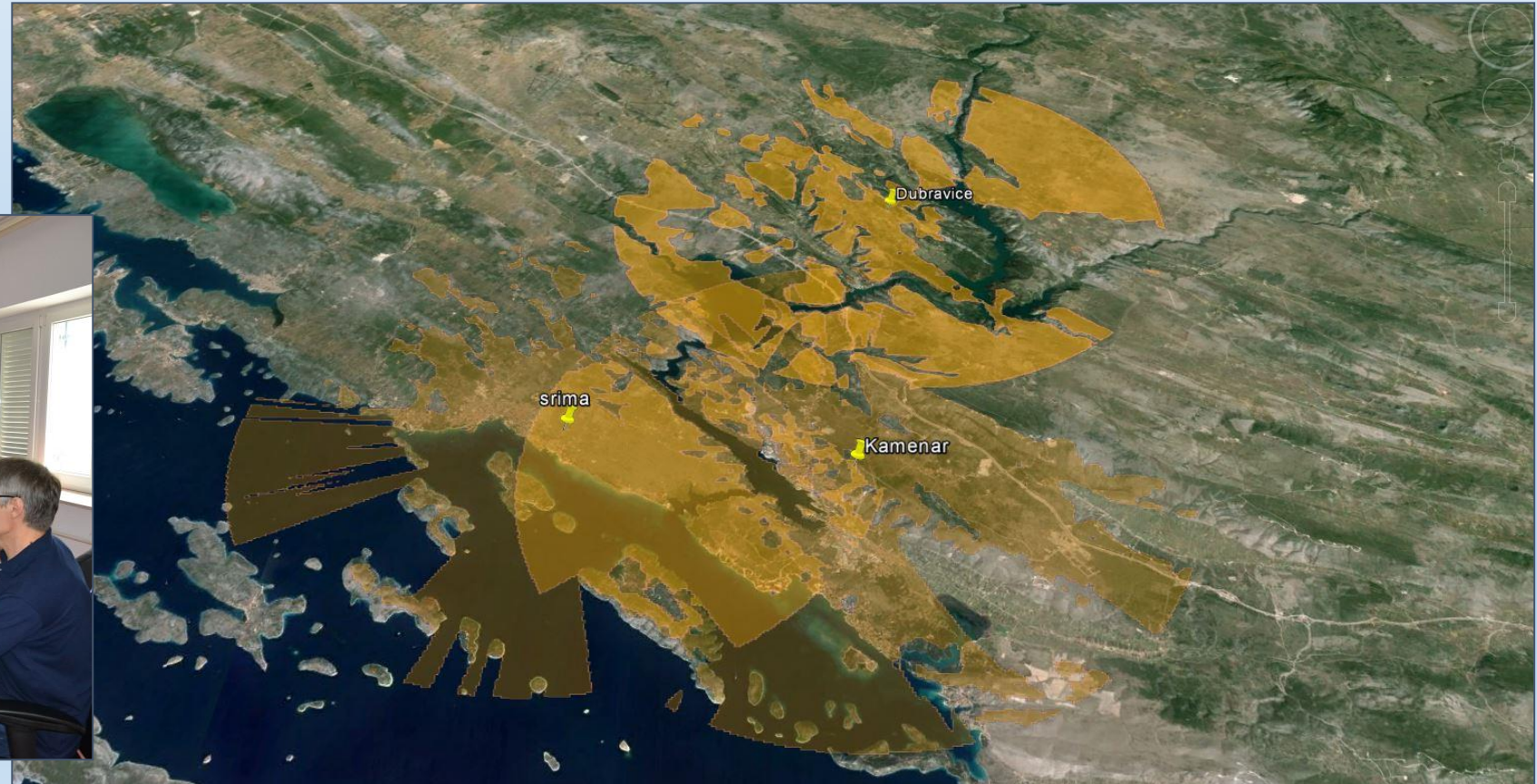
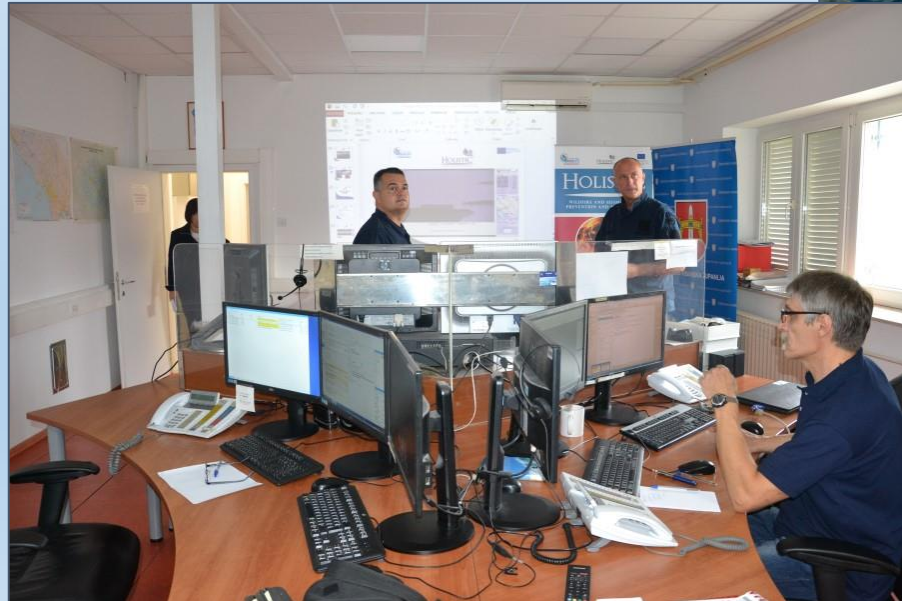
The Coastal Plan for Šibenik-Knin County a goal is twofold: sustainable development and building resilience of the County's coastal area.

3. Challenge

Fire prevention in the buffer zone



- Climate variability and change will cause increase of dry periods, thus increasing the risk of forest fires
- Human factors - increased number of visitors raise the risk of wildfires in the buffer zone
- Strengthening the prevention measures and coordination of monitoring are already being implemented in the buffer zone.

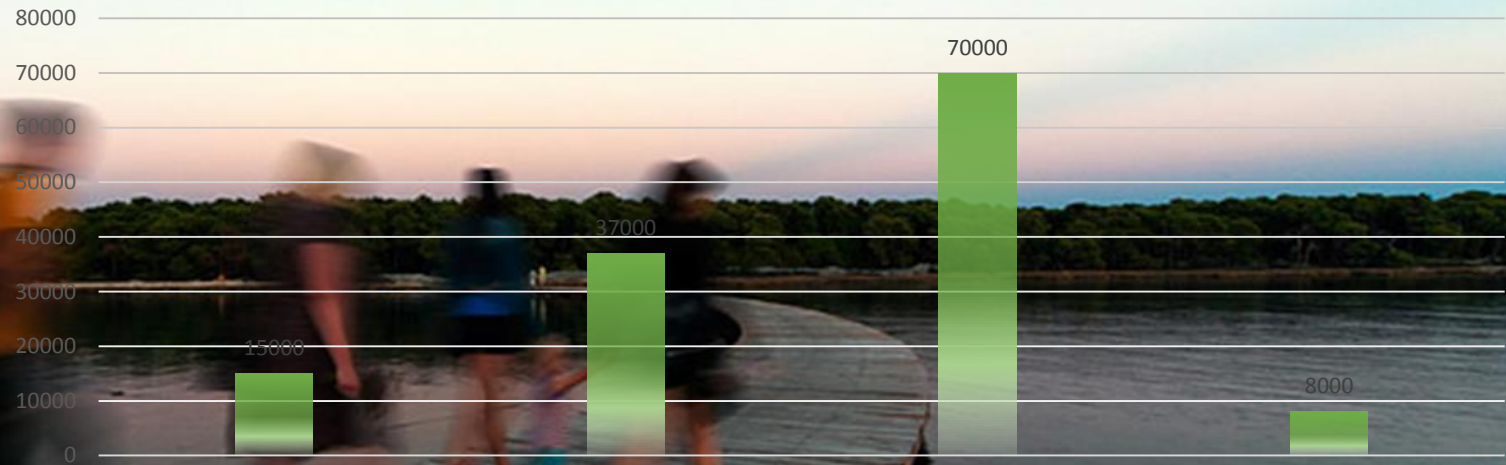

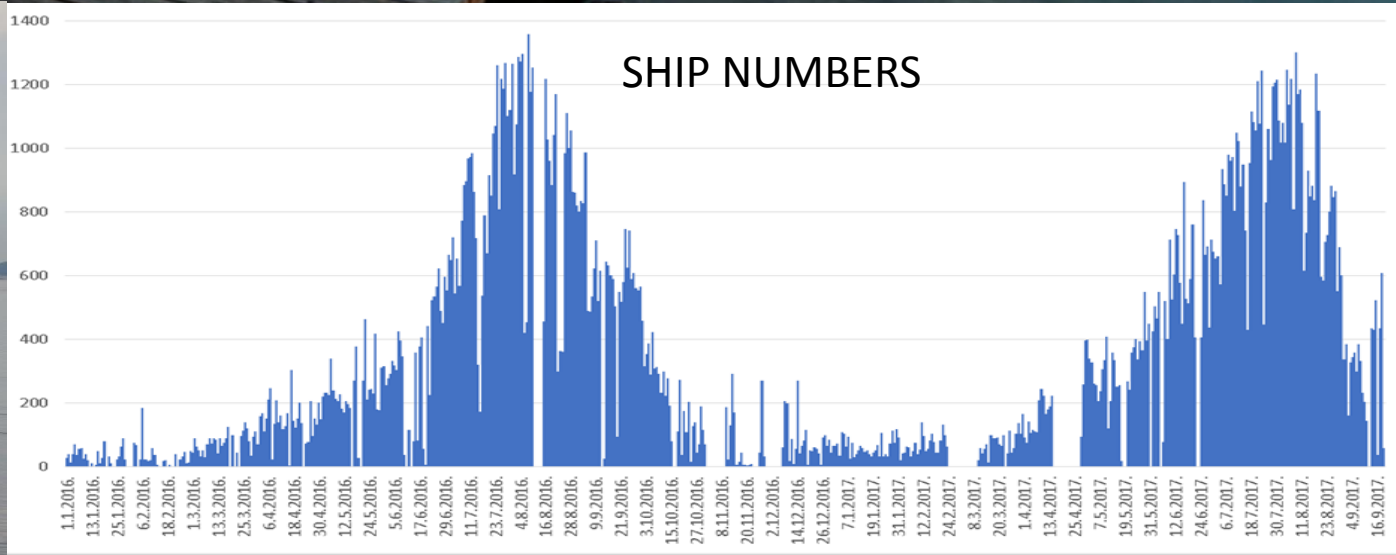
VISITOR NUMBERS 2016



These data are based on camera counting system set on the most frequent place on the walking path in St. Anthony's channel.

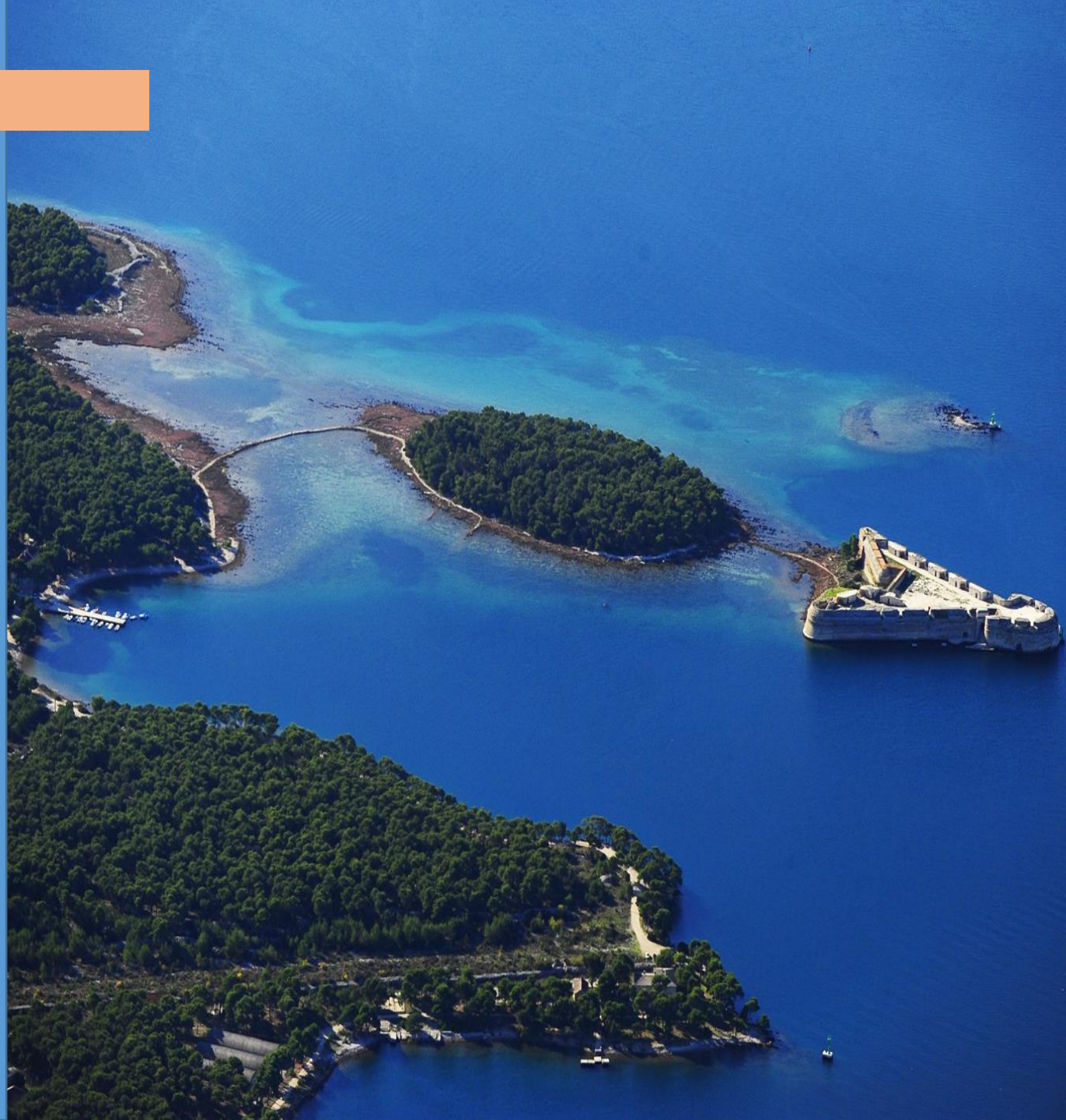


SHIP NUMBERS

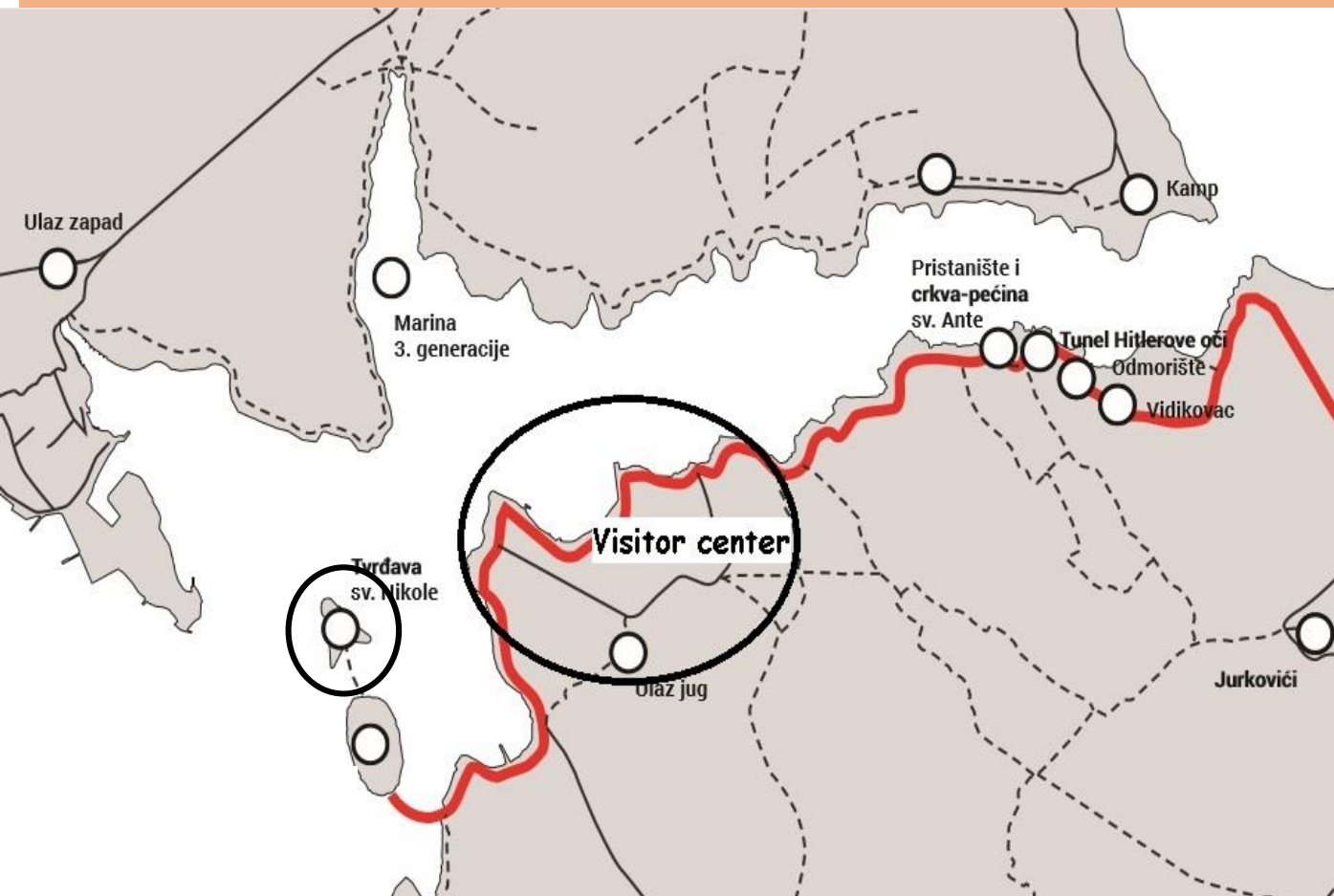


INTEGRATED Management Plan
