








Creation of a positive dynamic within the community to support the entrepreneurs



## Key results and achievements



Valuing local entrepreneurship



Tailored and shaped to local contexts with the active involvement of local stakeholders



Fostering alternative and environmentally friendly tourism



Promoting the creation of a circular economy between stakeholders, often previously disconnected



Facilitating access to innovative financing mechanisms (microcredits, impact investing, national and international financial partnerships)



Generating a specific local dynamic, that reaches beyond simple conservation issues, and revitalises neglected communities





Offering a **new context for greater cooperation** and partnerships



## **Challenges**

- Need time and resources to be present on site along the process,
- Need micro-credit to invest and start the businesses,
- Takes time to build strong relationships and understands the real needs,
- Not easy to work on a remote island in Covid time.





## **BBI** expansion

10 new sites across the Adriatic sea.









#### **Project Leader**

General coordinators, training of trainers (local BBI coordinators or enablers), communication in the Adriatic region, environmental monitoring and jury for funds eligibility.

### Technical assistants

Development of the BBI package, process manager and back-up support, impact measurement and support for international communication and jury for funds eligibility.

## Funding facilitators

Responsible for local funding mechanisms, responsible for package development for municipalities support, sustainability of BBIs and jury for funds eligibility.
